Then, as I said, life came and surprised me.


I'll never forget, it was a Thursday afternoon, about an hour before the end of my shift, when my boss came down to the


Wait just a minute, you might say, adding that you pray to Jesus and His Father to help you solve problems or some other issues. Could they really be your Friends as well?



Helpful Household Hints

It's still a couple months before spring cleaning, Dear Member. But that doesn't mean you can't get a jump on some pesky chores before then. And, if you have a household tip of your own please send it to us so we may publish it here in FAITH.

Magic Erasers

These are one of the handiest items imaginable for cleaning just about anything! Here's a list of several uses for the brand name and generic versions of this useful tool:

Scuff Marks -- One of the most popular uses for magic erasers is removing scuff marks. Whether the marks are on floors, walls, baseboards or more, magic erasers get the job done.

Young Artists -- Magic erasers do a great job at removing crayons, markers and more from walls and furniture.

Coffee and Tea Stains -- If you pull your favorite mug from the dishwasher and notice a not so nice ring around the rim, wipe it down with a magic eraser. The ring will be gone in no time.

Clean Shoes -- When you have tennis shoes that have lost their luster, use a magic eraser to clean the sides. They'll look as good as new again.

Remove Dried Paint -- The next time you are a little too messy with your paint, let it dry and

then clean with a magic eraser. This works great on a variety of hard surfaces like floors, walls and door hinges.

Soap Scum -- Magic erasers work great at abolishing soap scum in tubs and showers! They also work well on grout, tile and fiberglass. Be careful, because they are abrasive, and a little bit of scrubbing goes a long way.

Clean Dry Erase Boards -- When you have a lot of old marker left behind on a dry erase board, try rubbing it down with a magic eraser. The surface will be sparkling clean after very little effort.

No More Rust Stains

Here's how to remove those ugly rust stains from a faucet leak in a bathtub. Squeeze a lemon over the rust spot and cover the rusty areas with salt.

Let this mixture sit on the rusty area for three to four hours.

Finally, use a nylon scrubber to scrub the solution off, along with the rust stains.

The reason this home remedy works well is because of the acidity of the lemon, and the gentle abrasiveness of the salt.

Aspirin Refresh For Flowers

You can extend the life of fresh flowers by crushing aspirin and putting it into the water of a vase with filled with flowers.



Recipes From Your Friends

It's early in the New Year and we're bringing you some hearty recipes that are sure to warm up friends and family. These tasty dishes were contributed by your Fellow Members, so we'd love to hear from you, too, Dear Friend!

GOURMET CHICKEN

This dish is so good it's like eating in a nice restaurant, according to Member Irma F. from Connecticut.

Ingredients: 4 boneless, skinless chicken breast halves ... 3 tablespoons flour ... 1/2 teaspoon black pepper, divided ... 1/2 teaspoon salt, divided ... 2 tablespoons olive oil ... 1 14-1/2 ounce can diced tomatoes, undrained ... 1 can condensed French onion soup ... 1 cup grated Swiss cheese.

Combine flour and 1/2 of the salt and pepper. Dredge chicken in flour mixture and saute in olive oil until golden brown. Place in casserole. In same pan simmer tomatoes, onion soup and remaining salt and pepper for 5 minutes. Pour over chicken and sprinkle with cheese. Bake at 350 degrees about 25 minutes or until chicken is done.

MOLASSES CAKE

It's the molasses that makes

this cake a standout, Member Renata S. from Arizona says this is her family's favorite chocolate cake.

Ingredients: 1 teaspoon baking soda ... 1/2 cup boiling water ... 2 heaping tablespoons cocoa ... 2 tablespoons molasses ... 2 cups flour ... 2 cups sugar ... 1/2 cup butter ... 2 eggs ... 1 teaspoon salt ... 1 teaspoon vanilla ... 1 cup buttermilk.

Combine boiling water, soda, cocoa and molasses. Cool until lukewarm. Cream butter and sugar and beat in eggs. Add remaining dry ingredients and buttermilk alternately. Stir in vanilla and molasses mixture. Pour into greased 9 inch by 13 inch pan and bake at 350 degrees 35 minutes, or until cake tests done.

CHEESY BREAD STICKS

Darryl A., a Member from Boston, says these cheesy bread sticks can really spice up a nice pot of soup.

Ingredients: as many slices of white bread as you want ... some red pepper ... grated Parmesan cheese.

Remove crusts from bread and spread with soft butter. Cut into 1/2 inch strips. Sprinkle butter side with red pepper and dip in the cheese. Bake at 350 degrees for 5 minutes or until crisp.

The Lord Has A Better Idea Of What We Need!

Do you ever get impatient, Dear Member, when your prayers are not answered quickly, or in just the way you think they *should* be answered?

We ask this question because we often get letters from our Fellowship Friends wondering why the Lord didn't help them in the way they thought He was going to. It's natural for us to want to see the answers to our prayers as quickly as possible and in the way we had hoped they might be answered.

But the Lord has a better idea about what we need and when we need it. That's why He waits for just the right time and place to reveal the best way for us to reach a goal, or solve a problem.

Jesus spoke of this in the Bible Verse of Mark 4:28. "*For the Earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear; after that the full corn in the ear.*"

In other words, there is an orderly transition to be followed

in the Lord's blessings, and you will receive God's "full corn in the ear" when your prayer-seed has had the proper time to grow and blossom to receive His answer.

You see, Dear Member this orderly path allows you to grow and mature spiritually as well, so you are in the proper frame of mind to receive your blessing and act upon it.
