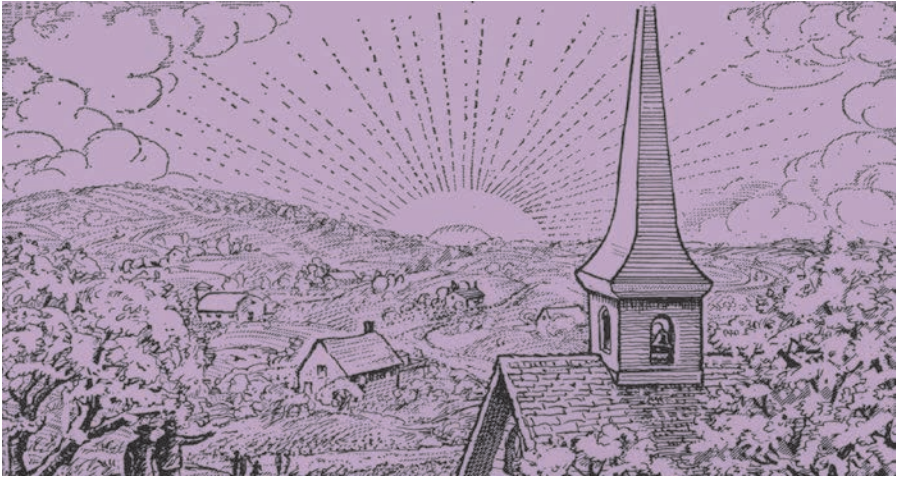

# If You Believe In God, He Can Help You Do Great Things!

One of the greatest passages in the Bible is short and simple. In Mark 9:23, it says . . . *“Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.”*

So, Dear Member, what does that mean? When we’re overwhelmed with problems and frustrations in life, it is wonderful to hear that everything is possible for those who believe in the Lord.

However, and this is important, that doesn’t mean we will get everything we think we want!

Here’s what Jesus *is* teaching. If you believe in God, then He can do anything in your life! It is a subtle but important difference. You see, God can do all things, and He does them according to His plan, according to His purpose and according to His will. That may not happen on our timelines, because God reveals His answer to our prayers on His time. And, it will be the answer He thinks we need, which isn’t necessarily what we think we want.

The Lord’s power to do good work in our lives is released through our faith in Him. That’s what is meant by the Bible Verse in Mark, where it says *“. . . all things are possible to him that believeth.”*

Now, perhaps you think you’ve got it all together and don’t need anyone else. You may think you’re powerful enough to make it all alone in this World, and strong enough to make things happen for yourself.

But, guess what? Eventually, there will be a time when that’s not enough. You still need faith! It’s through faith in God and His Son, Jesus, that you are given the ability to accomplish things you never imagined. Yes, Dear Member, if you can believe, and have faith, all things are possible! The Lord is with you always, and He’ll never let you down.

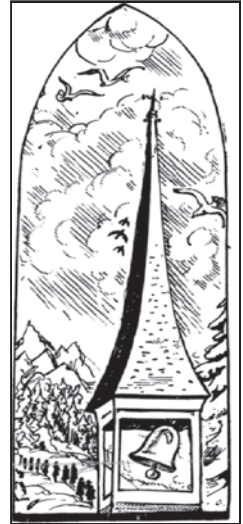

A young man came to a stream where he found an aged man slowly and painstakingly building a bridge across the water.

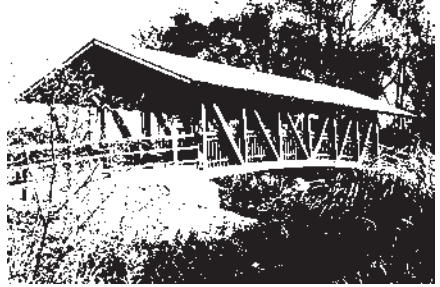
*“Why are you building this bridge at your age, when perhaps you may never live to cross it?”* asked the younger man.

# Prayer Is The Gateway To Enter The Presence Of God!

There is one gateway to enter the love and presence of God, Dear Member, and that is the gateway of sincere prayer. Through Fellowship's prayers you can find God, and stay close to Him.

All prayer is good, of course, but prayer can be so general and unfocused that it loses part of its power. We realized that long ago after a Fellow Member wrote to tell us she had been asked by a friend, "How, when and where do you pray?" And they added, "Why do you pray?"

As you can imagine, our Member was caught by surprise. But, she had a good answer. Here it is!

She turned to her friend and said, "Let's take the Lord's Prayer as an example and see if it answers your questions.

"The words *Our Father . . .* That tells you right away who is doing the praying, and it's you! It also tells you to whom you are praying.

"*Which art in Heaven . . .* That tells you where God is as you pray.

"*Hallowed be thy name . . .* It is God whom you honor when you pray. You are not praying to impress other people, nor are you putting your trust in Worldly things. You are putting your trust in His Holy Name!

"*Thy Kingdom come; Thy will be done . . .* That passage tells us not to give orders when we pray,



for God will determine how, when, and where He reveals His answer to our prayers.

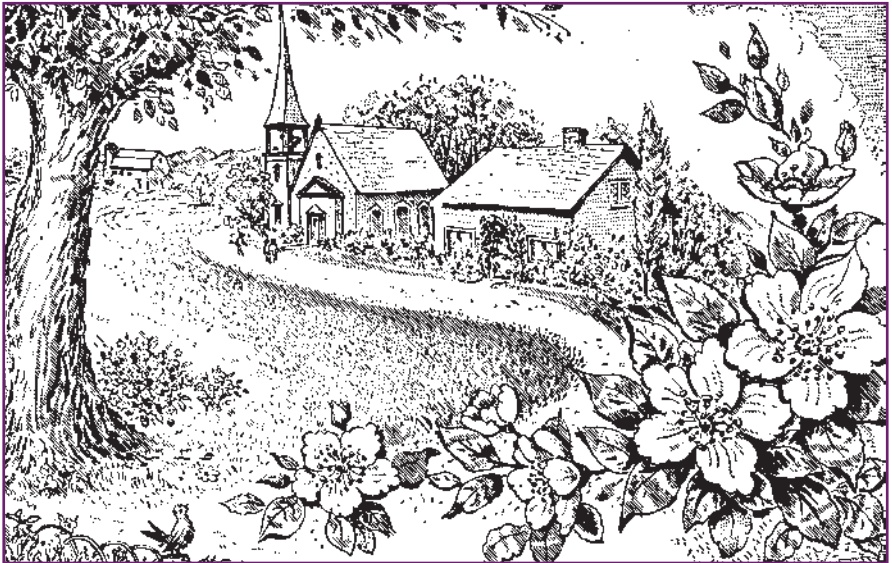

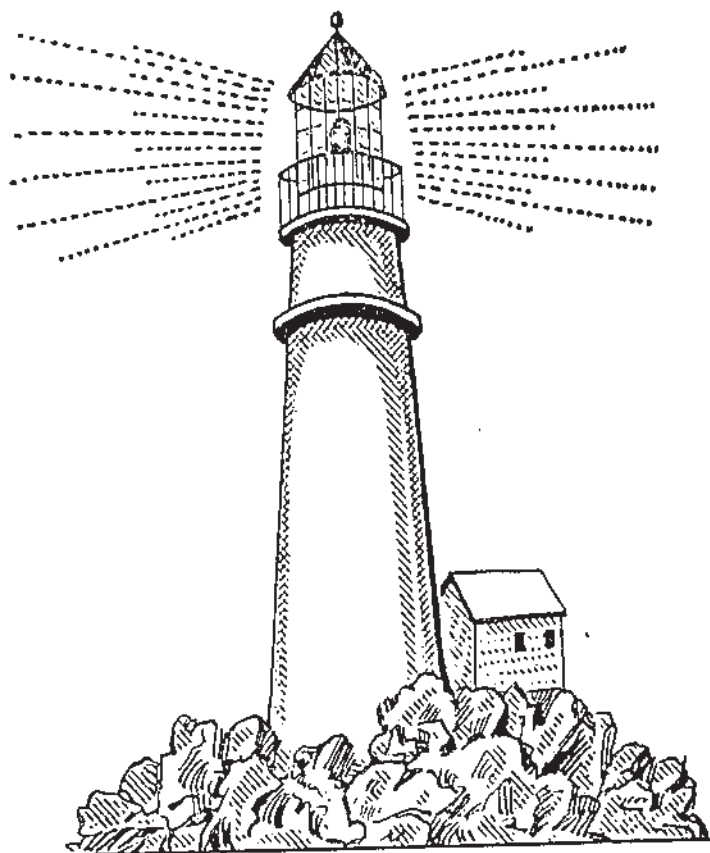

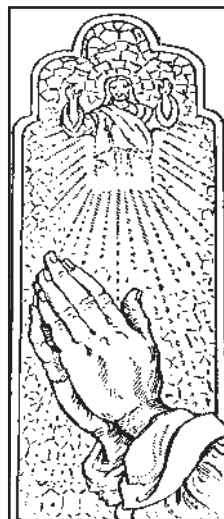

You can't beat this for a hearty one dish meal. Member Lida M. from Boston has our thanks for sharing such a delicious recipe.

Ingredients: 1 can condensed tomato soup, undiluted ... 2 pounds ground beef ... 1 can (2.8 ounces) French fried onions ... 1 egg, beaten ... 1/4 cup Worcestershire sauce ... 8 medium potatoes cut into quarters.

Mix 1/2 cup soup, beef, 1/2 can onions, egg and Worcestershire thoroughly. Shape into loaf and place potatoes around meatloaf. Bake at 350 degrees 1 hour, then stir potatoes, spoon remaining soup over meatloaf and bake 25 more minutes. Then sprinkle remaining onions over meatloaf and cook additional 5 minutes or until onions are golden brown.

### **SAVORY BISCUITS**

Member Dorothy C. from Miami says these wonderful biscuits were inspired by a certain

fast-food chain. Can you guess?

Ingredients: 2 cups Bisquick mix ... 2/3 cup milk ... 1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese ... 1/2 cup butter, melted ... 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder.

Mix Bisquick, milk and cheese until soft dough forms; beat vigorously for 30 seconds. drop dough by spoonfuls onto an ungreased cookie sheet. Bake 8 to 10 minutes, or until browned, at 450 degrees. Mix butter and garlic powder and brush mixture over warm biscuits before removing from cookie sheet.

### **FUDGEY PUDDING CAKE**

It's a pudding ... it's a cake ... it's rich and gooey ... and it's from Member Josie S. in California. Try it, you'll love it!

Ingredients: 1 cup Bisquick mix ... 1/4 cup cocoa ... 1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk ... 3/4 cup chocolate syrup, divided ... 1 teaspoon vanilla ... 1/2 cup hot water.

Combine Bisquick and cocoa, stir in 1 cup condensed milk, 1/4 cup syrup and vanilla. Spoon evenly into 8 inch square baking pan. Combine remaining 1/2 cup syrup, condensed milk and hot water. Pour carefully over mixture in pan, do not stir. Bake 25 to 30 minutes or until center is set. Let stand 15 minutes before serving.
