And with that inspiring note, Dear Friend, we hope you are refreshed and energized by this Summertime edition of FAITH!




You might be saying to yourself, well sure, but how is this like a vacation? Allow us to explain.


It was a dark time for me, Dear Fellowship. I didn't know where to turn.


JULY — Fellowship's DAILY PRAYERS

Some Members have inquired about how they might make a bequest to Life-Study Fellowship.

Through the years, many Members have chosen to remember our Fellowship in this special way and we are truly grateful. Some Members have included Fellowship in their wills, while others have named Life-Study Fellowship in their life insurance policies.

If you are interested in making arrangements through your will, we suggest you talk with an attorney who can explain the tax advantages and ways to go about making such a bequest.

Please remember that it is to everybody's advantage to have a will. This doesn't apply just to the very wealthy. The truth is everyone who owns any property needs a will to direct who should benefit.

Otherwise, some or all of your property will be split up according to state law, which may leave your property in ways you did not want or intend.

Therefore, whether or not you include a bequest to Life-Study Fellowship, we encourage you to seek the services of an attorney to have a will drawn up if you have not already done so.

HAWAIIAN CHICKEN

Member Kelli B. lives in Honolulu and wants you to try her recipe for this easy and unusual chicken dish.

Ingredients: 4 boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cut into strips ... 3 Tablespoons vegetable oil, divided ... 4 medium carrots, cut into thin slices ... 1 medium onion, sliced thin ... 1/2 cup soy sauce ... 1/4 cup brown sugar ... cooked rice.

In large skillet stir-fry chicken in 2 Tablespoons oil for 6 or 8 minutes. Remove chicken and set aside. In the same pan stir-fry carrots and onions in remaining oil until crisp-tender. Combine soy sauce and brown sugar; add to pan and bring to a boil. Return chicken to pan and boil 5 minutes or until sauce thickens. Serve over hot cooked rice.

COOL APPLE SALAD

In the summertime Addie F. from Boston says this cool, tasty salad just fills the bill. It's good, and it's good for you, too!

2 cups diced apples ... 2 cups chopped celery ... 1 cup mayonnaise ... 1/2 cup walnuts ... 1 cup green grapes. Combine all ingredients and chill. You'll love it!

SUMMER-SATIONAL PIE

Rush to the kitchen right now and try this mouth watering dessert. It makes 2 pies and we thank Member Linda M., in Georgia for sharing this scrumptious treat with us.

Ingredients: 1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk ... 1 (6 ounce) can frozen limeade, thawed and undiluted ... 1/2 cup lime juice ... 3 drops green food coloring ... 2 (8 ounce) cartons whipped topping ... 2 prepared chocolate crumb crusts.

Combine first 4 ingredients in large mixing bowl, beating at medium speed until well blended. Set aside 1 cup of whipped topping. Fold remainder of whipped topping into lime mixture and spoon into prepared crusts. Spoon a dollop of reserved whipped topping on top of both pies and chill.

That's because it's best to talk with someone who can understand you and how you are feeling about the matter weighing upon your mind.




