Helpful Household Hints

It's that time of the year again ... time to tackle the deep cleaning for spring and banish the musty odor of winter. We've put together some tips to help you do that, Dear Member. They'll help you declutter, organize and freshen up your home. Please feel free to share your own ideas with us, too!

CLEARING CLUTTER

Purchase containers that are the right size for their contents. Limit items in a collection, like memorabilia or craft supplies, to one drawer or bin. When it gets full, don't buy another container! Purge the one you have of things you haven't used and don't need! . . . **Use Open Storage.** Because it's out in public, you're more likely to keep things pared down—closed cabinets and lidded boxes make it too easy to tuck away new stuff. . . **Don't Collect Everything!** Buy things because you'll enjoy them, not just because you feel you have to complete a set. . . **Avoid Buying Items in Bulk!** Bulk packaging isn't always a good idea, particularly if you have a small family. Buy bundles of nonperishable items only when you truly have the space. . . **Don't Get Sucked in By Sales!** It doesn't matter how much something costs if you don't need it in the first place. . . **Keep a basket on your coffee table!** . . . A small, open basket on

the coffee table keeps remote controls from slipping between sofa cushions.

NO MORE GRIMY GROUT

You may think your dingy tile and grout is beyond hope, but with the right products and a little scrubbing, you can easily renew and refresh it! Just try this cleaning routine. First, sprinkle a medium to generous amount of Bon Ami, or a similar cleaning powder, over the surface, making sure the powder covers all the grout. Spray the surface with a mixture of equal parts white vinegar and water. Dip a cleaning brush in water and then scrub the surface. The powder, spray solution, and water will combine to make a paste. Let this paste sit on the surface for 5-10 minutes. Rinse and wipe down the surface.

Of course, I also thank my Fellow Members for your United Prayers in which I have joined with you all these years. I surely hope my prayers have helped

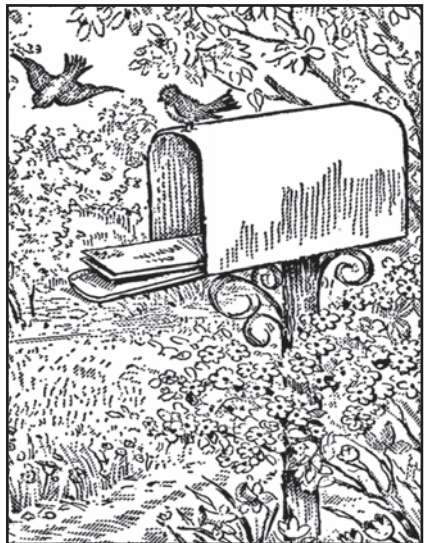
you, too! I thank God and our Fellowship for the glorious ways in which our prayers have been answered.

"GO BANANAS" MUFFINS

Your family will "go bananas" over these delicious muffins! Member Lateesha D. from New York says that's because they taste so "heavenly."

Ingredients: 1 egg, 2 cups Bisquick baking mix ... 1 cup ripe bananas, mashed ... 1/4 cup sugar ... 2 tablespoons milk ... 2 tablespoons melted butter ... 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg ... 1/2 cup chopped pecans.

Heat oven to 400 degrees. Grease bottom only of 12 muffin cups. Beat egg slightly, stir in remaining ingredients until just moistened. Divide batter evenly among cups. Bake until golden brown, 15 to 17 minutes.

GOLDEN DREAM PIE

Member Phyllis M. from Florida is right when she says this pie tastes like a dream. You'll think so, too, because it's pretty, it's easy to make, and it's just full of

flavor.

Ingredients: 3/4 stick butter, melted ... 3 eggs ... 3 tablespoons flour ... 1 cup sugar ... 1 cup crushed pineapple, drained ... 1 cup coconut flakes ... 9 inch, deep dish unbaked pie shell.

Mix first 6 ingredients well and pour into pie shell. Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour, or until browned and set.

CORNY EGGS

Corn adds surprising crunch and sweetness to these melt-in-your-mouth scrambled eggs. We thank Member Mrs. J. P. in Indiana for sharing it with us.

Ingredients: 6 eggs ... 1 can (8 1/2 ounces) cream-style corn... 1/2 pound cooked, crumbled bacon ... 2 tablespoons butter ... salt and pepper to taste.

Beat eggs and add corn, bacon and salt and pepper. Melt butter in skillet, pour in egg mixture, and cook, stirring, until eggs are completely set.

HEALTHY HINT: Trying to lose weight? Don't skip meals, you'll often be hungrier and eat more at the next meal. To save calories try using grill pans that drain grease from food, steamers, non-stick pans and cooking sprays to cut extra fat from your diet. Food will taste good and be healthier.

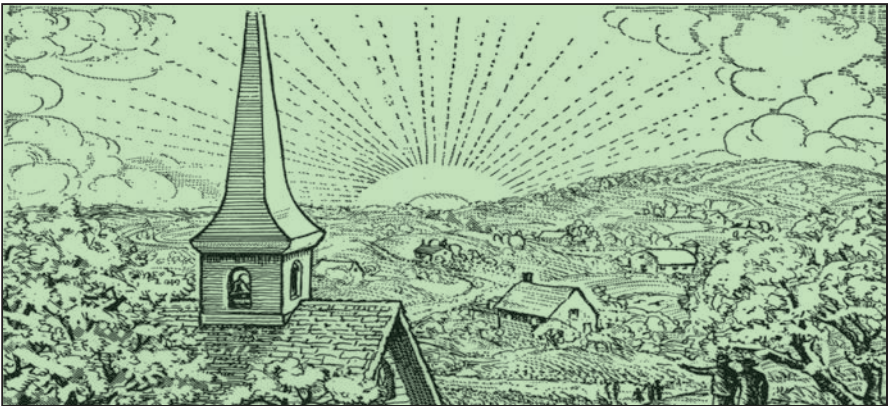

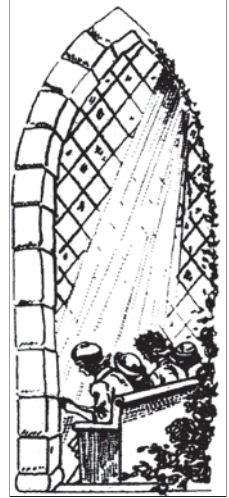
