

We hope you like our Giving-themed FAITH, Dear Friend, and that you'll stay in touch with us, too.



My Dear Fellowship Friends, I’m sure you’ve heard the phrase “Pay it forward.” Well, my story is about benefiting from someone else’s kindness and doing just that! The experience made me a more giving person and made me think about how that fits in with how I think the Lord wants us to act.

I grew up in the Midwest in a close-knit family. Dad was a truck driver and Mom held down the fort at home, keeping us kids fed, clothed and getting us off to school. It really was a great childhood.

Eventually, I got a job myself and married a man I had known as a boy who lived nearby. We had children of our own, and he had a good job at a factory a few miles away. We had a wonderful life together, until one day I got a call from his workplace that something awful had happened. My husband had been badly injured by some industrial machinery!

I rushed to the hospital to see him in Intensive Care, with broken bones and hooked up to an array of medical equipment. The doctors said they had saved his life, but weren’t sure if he could ever totally recover.

I was distraught and frightened. Without my husband’s paycheck, how would we pay the bills? That night, as I sat in a

chair in the corner of his hospital room, I prayed silently: “Dear Jesus, please heal my husband and help us get through this!” At that moment, I felt a calm come over me. Suddenly, I knew the Lord had answered my prayer and my husband and family would be OK.

Unbeknown to me, my husband’s coworkers had collected a sizable donation to tide us over the three-month recovery period until he was able to go back to work.

A couple years later, one of my husband’s friends also was hurt in an accident at work. I immediately volunteered to collect contributions to help out that gentleman and his family. It felt like the right thing to do since my loved ones had been given so much.

I think of the Bible Verse in II Corinthians 9:7, which says: “Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.”

I’m happy to be God’s “cheerful giver” whenever I can do so!



Bless This Home

Helpful Household Hints

Need to know the best and quickest way to clean house? Read on, Dear Member, because your Fellowship Friends have some great Household Hints! We'd love to hear your helpful tips as well. Write in so we can share them in FAITH!

* * *

REMOVE A SPLINTER

When you get a splinter, reach for the scotch tape before resorting to tweezers or a needle. Simply put the scotch tape over the splinter, then pull it off. Scotch tape usually removes most splinters painlessly and easily.

* * *

MAKE LEMONADE

To get the most juice out of fresh lemons, bring them to room temperature and roll them under your palm against the kitchen counter before squeezing.

TAKE THE CAKE

When a cake recipe calls for flouring the baking pan, use a bit of the dry cake mix instead. No more white flour on the outside of the cake!

* * *

SOAP UP

Before painting, scrubbing the oven, or digging in any dirt,

scrape some soap from a wet bar of soap under and around your fingernails. This will prevent other things from getting under your nails. This is a useful hint for people who start out using rubber gloves or garden gloves, and then pull them off halfway through the job.

IT'S THE FIZZ

Hate cleaning the toilet? Drop in two Alka-Seltzer tablets, wait 20 minutes, brush and flush. The citric acid and effervescent action does the cleaning.

* * *

NO MORE DRIPS

Stuff a miniature marshmallow in the bottom of a sugar cone to prevent ice cream drips.

* * *

HOMEMADE DISINFECTANT

Mix 1/2 cup borax (a natural mineral that kills mold and bacteria) with 1 gallon hot water. Add a few sprigs of fresh thyme. Steep for 10 minutes, strain and cool. Store in a recycled plastic spray bottle.

* * *

OVEN CLEANER

To make your own oven cleaner, make a paste of baking soda and hot water. Sponge onto stains and wipe clean.

The Lord has always taken such wonderful care of us, and I made up my mind right then not to worry about this matter over which I had no control. God would do what was best.


We were back home in only a few days, Dear Friends, when an envelope arrived in the mail.

Recipes From Your Friends

OMELET TREAT

Member Annie M. from Florida makes a light and tasty lunch or supper for three people this way: Beat 6 eggs, 1/3 cup milk and 1 envelope cheese sauce, then mix together well. Melt 2 tablespoons of butter in a skillet and pour in egg mixture. Cook slowly until eggs are set, but still moist. Fold omelet in half and slide onto plate.

CARROT BAKE

Fresh carrots are always in the market and they are full of vitamins. Member Elaine S. from Montana cooks them like this:

Ingredients: Boil 10 medium carrots in salted water. When tender, drain, mash and then add . . . 1 cup milk . . . 1 cup fine bread crumbs . . . 2 eggs . . . 1/4 cup melted butter . . . salt and pepper to taste.

Blend well and place in

greased casserole dish. Bake in a 325-degree oven until golden brown -- about 1 hour. Everyone will love carrots cooked like this!

APPLE TEA CAKE

Member Rose R. from Georgia says this delightful cake keeps well in the freezer until you are ready to reheat and serve it to guests.

Ingredients: 1-1/2 cups all purpose flour . . . 2 teaspoons baking powder . . . 1/4 teaspoon salt . . . 1/3 cup softened butter . . . 1 cup sugar . . . 1 teaspoon vanilla . . . 2 large eggs . . . 1/2 cup evaporated milk . . . 1 large unpeeled apple, diced . . . 1/2 cup chopped walnuts.

Grease bottom of loaf pan measuring 9 x 5 x 3. Stir together flour, baking powder and salt. Cream butter, sugar and vanilla together; then beat in eggs one at a time until blended. Add flour mixture, milk, apple and walnuts to this, and stir just until dry ingredients are moistened. Spoon into greased pan.

Bake at 350 degrees about 65 minutes. Loosen edges of cake from pan after removing it from the oven to let it cool. We believe everyone who is lucky enough to sample this tasty cake will say it's delicious!

Fellowship's Special Help Department was created especially for that purpose, to help you get the prayer help you want, and need, to take your problems to the Lord.




If you are interested in making arrangements through your will, we suggest you talk with an attorney who can explain the tax advantages and ways to go about making such a bequest.


