

Helpful Household Hints

It's almost Christmastime, Dear Friend, and Your Fellow Members have some ideas about how to make the holidays more fun and less stressful. We hope you find these tips helpful as you get ready to host friends and family this holiday season!

TREE RESIN

Let's face it, we love the scent of a real Christmas tree, but they can be a bit messy. If you get tree sap on your hands when you haul your new evergreen inside, here's how to remove it. Instead of soap and water, try using that bottle of hand sanitizer that most of us have round! It contains alcohol, which will help to break up the resin on your skin.





Recipes From Your Friends

It's Christmastime, when guests often stop by for a visit and the scent of holiday baking fills the air. Our Members have some wonderful holiday dishes to share with you, Dear Friend, so we invite you to try them out! Be sure to send us a recipe or two that you love to make, too!

CRANBERRY BREAD

Member Felicia S. from Maine says she loves to make this holiday bread so she has it on hand to serve guests who drop by. It's a finger food that doesn't require much cleanup, either.

Ingredients: 2 cups sifted flour . . . 1 cup sugar . . . ½ teaspoon salt . . . ½ teaspoon baking powder . . . ½ teaspoon soda . . .

Sift together and add the grated rind of one orange. Then add: 1 beaten egg . . . 2 tablespoons oil . . . 2 tablespoons hot water . . . ½ cup orange juice.

Fold in:

½ cup cut pecans . . . 1 cup cranberries, halved.

Pour into a loaf pan and bake for 1 hour and 10 minutes at 325 degrees. Remove loaf and wrap in wax paper. After 3 hours remove the wax paper and wrap tightly in foil. Refrigerate overnight before serving.

FESTIVE PORK CHOPS

This recipe makes a holiday entree that's sure to bring compliments. We're glad Member

Tammy R. from Iowa shared it with us.

Ingredients: 4 to 6 pork chops . . . 4 cups sliced apples . . . ½ cup sugar . . . 2 teaspoons flour . . . ½ teaspoon cinnamon . . . 1 package seasoned coating for pork.

Place apples in a well-greased casserole. Mix sugar, flour and spices together and sprinkle over applies. Coat pork chops with the seasoned coating, and arrange on top of the applies.

Bake in a preheated, 400-degree oven for about one hour.

CARROT SHEET CAKE

Member Sheila N. of North Carolina wrote in to tell us about this cake, which is a delicious alternative to chocolate or vanilla. It's sure to be a popular dessert or snack with coffee or tea over the holidays.

Ingredients: 2 cups sugar . . . 3 cups grated carrots . . . 2 teaspoons baking soda . . . 1 teaspoon salt . . . 1½ cups oil . . . 4 eggs beaten . . . 2 teaspoons cinnamon . . . 2 cups plain flour . . . Mix sugar with oil and eggs. Add flour, baking soda, salt and cinnamon. Beat well. Add pecans and carrots. Combine well. Pour into large, greased Pyrex or oven-safe baking dish. Bake in preheated, 350-degree oven for 45 minutes or until cake tests done.
