

### **“Cast Thy Burden Upon The Lord”**

*Psalms 55:22*



The approach of a New Year is always filled with anticipation, Dear Friend, as we cast off old thinking and habits from last year and start anew.

*"I just want to thank you for sending me the most beautiful prayers to help me talk to the Lord about getting my son some help for his drug problem. I have done everything I can myself, and nothing has worked. So, I knew I*



*needed to bring in the ultimate adviser, God. I received my prayer help in just a short time, and began using my prayers in the morning and at night. And, I'm happy to say that, little by little, I began noticing a change in my son! He told me he really is trying to get off the drugs he was using. We went to a clinic that helps people like him and he has been going to classes there and taking medication to help with the physical side effects.*

*Now, I am very hopeful that I'll get back the boy I raised, thanks to the loving intervention of God and help from all of you in Fellowship."*

Sandy's story is a reminder just how powerful prayers can be, and how God offers assistance on His timeline to give the best effect, not ours.



Ingredients: Two 15 ounce cans mixed vegetables, well drained ... 1 cup chopped celery... 1 cup chopped onion... 1 cup mayonnaise ... 1 cup shredded cheese... 1/2 teaspoon Worcestershire Sauce ... salt and pepper to taste ... 1 cup buttered crumbs.

Mix everything except crumbs. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes. Remove from oven, sprinkle with crumbs and bake an additional 5 minutes or until lightly browned.

### **Company Cornbread**

Her friends always ask for more of this tasty cornbread and Member V. H. A. from Virginia thinks you will, too.

Ingredients: 1 cup self-rising cornmeal ... 2 teaspoons baking powder ... 1 tablespoon sugar ...

1/2 cup vegetable oil. 2 eggs, beaten ... 8 ounces sour cream ... 8 1/2 ounce can cream style corn.

Mix all ingredients well and bake in a greased 9 inch square pan at 400 degrees for 35 to 40 topping.

### **Pleasing Pie**

Everyone drops by when Member M. B. from Canada cooks this delicious pie that makes its own crust. Just wait till you taste it.

Ingredients: 3/4 cup sugar... 1/2 cup Bisquick ... 2 tablespoons margarine, softened... 13 ounce can evaporated milk ... 2 eggs ... 16 ounce can pumpkin ... 2 1/2 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice... 2 teaspoons vanilla.

Beat all ingredients until smooth. Pour into well greased 10 inch pie plate and bake at 350 degrees for 55 minutes, or until a knife inserted in the center comes out clean.

**QUICK HINT . . .** If you've made too much whipped cream, don't let it go to waste. Save it for future use by spooning individual dollops onto a cookie sheet and freezing them. Then seal well in a plastic bag and keep in your freezer. This way you'll have instant toppings for puddings and cakes!




