My Fellowship Friends,

I want to tell you my story because I hope it will help someone else overcome fear that stands between them and accomplishing a goal.

I've wanted to be a first responder since I was little, and saw firefighters helping people who were in a car accident. Young as I was, I was so amazed and impressed at how calm they were while everyone around them were crying and upset. My parents, who were longtime Members of Fellowship, supported that effort. When I was in high school, they let me start working at the local fire station, helping to clean up and organize equipment.

Once I was old enough, I began taking classes in medical training and other subjects, learning to become a paramedic. It took a while, but finally, I graduated and began working with the first responders I had wanted to join for so long! I was so happy, and enjoyed my job, even though it was stressful at times.

One day, my fellow medics and I heard a call over our speaker system that chilled us all. There had been a shooting in the parking lot of a grocery store and several people were hurt. My ambulance raced to the scene, lights flashing and sirens wailing. When we arrived, we found several teens and one younger



boy had been shot. I knelt down with my partner to help the boy and suddenly he stopped breathing. My Friends, right at that moment, I suddenly felt like I was frozen in fear. I had never had such a thing happen in my short time as a paramedic. As I started chest compressions, I began praying to the Lord, asking Him to quell my fears and help this little boy survive.

After a minute of my partner and me working on him, the boy began breathing again and opened his eyes! We took him to the hospital, where the doctors were able to save his life.

I am so grateful to God for hearing my prayer and helping that child, as well as dispelling my worry and fear. I don't know what would have happened if He hadn't gotten involved. Since then, I've called upon the Lord many times for support, and He has always answered my prayers! God is truly great!



### **12:00 Noon Prayer for Prosperity**



Dear Member, it has been a year of positive happenings on one hand, but concerns still linger about Covid-19 and its continuing potential to affect our health and welfare.



### BOB'S POT ROAST

Member Bob E., in Connecticut says this recipe for pot roast is unforgettable. We're sure you'll remember the flavor, too!

Ingredients: 3 pound beef roast ... 1 (1 pound) can of diced tomatoes ... 1 teaspoon ketchup ... 1 onion, chopped ... salt and pepper ... 2 cups water.

Sear roast in hot fat until brown. Add onions and cook until soft. Add salt and pepper, tomatoes, ketchup and 2 cups water. Cover, and cook in 300 degree oven for 2 hours, then check for doneness. Check liquid occasionally and add more water if necessary. Thicken gravy to taste.

### ROY'S DUMPLINGS

Roy's favorite recipe goes well with Bob's pot roast. Member Roy W., from Canada loves these

fluffy dumplings!

Ingredients: 1 cup flour ... 3 teaspoons baking powder ... 1/4 teaspoon salt ... 1 1/2 Tablespoons vegetable oil ... 1/2 cup water.

Mix flour, baking powder and salt in bowl. Make a well and add water and oil. Mix lightly. Drop by the tablespoon into simmering soup or gravy. Cover and cook 15 minutes without raising cover. Remove dumplings immediately and serve.

### EVA'S COOKIES

If Member Eva W., from Georgia, makes her favorite tea cookies they disappear quickly ... and we can understand why!

Ingredients: 1/2 cup butter ... 1 cup sugar ... 1 egg ... 1/2 teaspoon salt ... 4 Tablespoons milk ... 2 cups flour ... 1/2 teaspoon vanilla.

Cream butter and sugar until soft. Add remaining ingredients and mix to make a stiff dough. Roll dough to 1/2 inch thick, cut into rounds and bake on cookie sheet at 400 degrees for 12 minutes, or until golden brown on bottom.

Therefore, whether or not you include a bequest to Life-Study Fellowship, we encourage you to seek the services of an attorney to have a will drawn up if you have not already done so.
