## Words Of Wisdom And Inspiration!



A New Year is knocking on the door, Dear Member, which means the New Year edition of Faith Magazine is in the mail and headed to you and your Fellowship Friends.

This year, we are highlighting the wisdom imparted by the Book of Proverbs, in which King Solomon counsels his son ... and all who read this Biblical chapter ... how to act wisely, avoid tempta-

tion and make good choices. Central to Solomon's teachings is the idea that God is concerned with the choices we make and how we live our lives, because He wants the best for us.

For instance, in the Bible Verse of Proverbs 3:5, Solomon urges his son, and his people, to *"Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding."*

It is important, he stresses, for people not to be led astray by peer pressure or outside influences.

Above all, Solomon teaches that our choices will directly result in either good or bad things happening, depending on how we stick to the path God lays out for us.

On Page 6, Member Theresa J. from Maryland discusses how she hopes God will create a healing journey for her friends and relatives who are battling cancer. As so many of our Fellowship Friends do, she requested special prayer help for those folks, as well as for her own health concerns.

*“I use my Daily Bible Verses every day and I am looking forward to great things happening throughout my day. I can feel God’s power moving,”* Theresa declared.

On page 23, Member M. J., from Alabama, also writes about God’s power to make positive change in the lives of faithful believers. She recalled how she felt *“empty and lost,”* after she divorced an abusive husband.

*“Yes, that’s exactly how I felt, lost and tired of the life I was living,”* she said. *“That’s because I was divorced with two sons, ages six and nine . . . It was a frightening time!”*

On my job, I am a material handler and I have a production rate that I have to make daily. I work the third shift and my production usually is 170 units per hour. On a recent night, my first day back at work after being off for a holiday, my production rate was up to 198 units an hour!

I did not know I had done that much; I was surprised; but I know it was the strength of the Bible Verse I had in my pocket that night. My supervisor was happy. He said “*Keep that up!*” I said, “*What a way to start out a New Year!*”

# God Is Concerned With The Choices We Make And How We Live!

Dear Member, we chose the theme of this New Year edition of Faith Magazine ... *The Book Of Proverbs: Words Of Wisdom And Inspiration!* ... to start the year off with the wise teachings of Solomon, the son of David, king of Israel.

Much of the Proverbs are about Solomon speaking as a father teaching his son, and his people, lessons about how to live their lives.

As it reads in Proverbs 1:2-5, Solomon spoke of the need *"To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding;*

*"To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity;*

*"To give subtilty to the simple,*

*to the young man knowledge and discretion.*

*"A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels."*

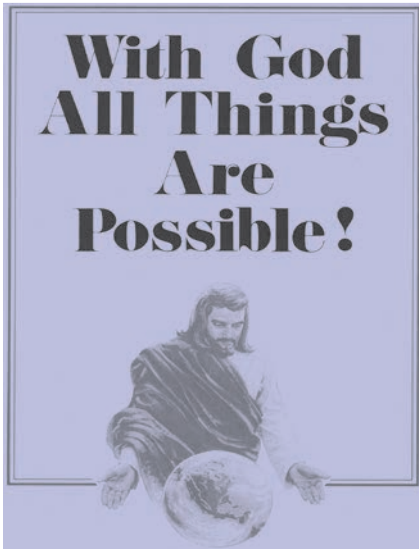
In particular, Solomon was teaching his son ... and all of us reading these Scriptures now ... how to live in accordance with God's teachings, or covenants.

One key Verse is found in Proverbs 1:7: *"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction."*

In this way, Solomon instructs a young man to act wisely, be diligent and honest in work, and to avoid being tempted into "folly" or "wickedness," especially by the young man's peers. That's stated plainly in Proverbs 1:10, *"My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not."*

Solomon also emphasizes in Proverbs 3:5, *"Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding."*

A central message in Proverbs is that God is concerned with the choices we make and how we live our lives. And, our choices will result in either good or bad effects in the future, depending on how they intersect with His covenants. Indeed, Dear Member, the Book of Proverbs provided words to live by in ancient times, as well as today!

# Take A Break For Some Quiet Time With The Lord!

All around us, we see people rushing to and from work, school or errands. Often, they're driving too fast, and hurrying through the day as if they are running on a treadmill.

Dear Member, that experience is the pressure we often feel in daily life, and it can take a physical toll as well as stress people out mentally. You might find the muscles in your neck start to hurt, or you get a headache. That's a big signal that it's time to plan a serenity break, and plan for some "quiet time with the Lord."

Your own personal quiet time with God, also known as prayer time, doesn't have to come at any special hour of the day or night. Just pick a time that suits you best, and devote maybe five or 10 minutes when you can relax a bit and talk to Him. It helps to find a place where you aren't going to be disturbed and you can have a serene, calm talk with God in your own words. (*We do know that's harder than it sounds when you have young children!*)

You don't even have to pray about a specific issue during this quiet time. No Dear Friend, just tell Him what's on your mind, what's going on in your life and anything you're planning for the future. The key is just to relax and calm yourself as much as possible, rather than talking



about problems.

You'll soon notice how the tension of your day starts to fade away. Pressure that has been building up within you will ease, because you are in the calm and healing presence of God.

We can't emphasize enough that this quiet time with Him doesn't need to be formal, because the Lord doesn't worry about how well you're dressed or whether your home is spotless. He loves us, His children, and wants to provide you the peace you need to help you unwind and see things more clearly.

So, Dear Friend, we hope you will set aside a few precious minutes for yourself in quiet time with the Lord. You really will feel the difference as He helps you refresh your energy and ease the pressures of the day!

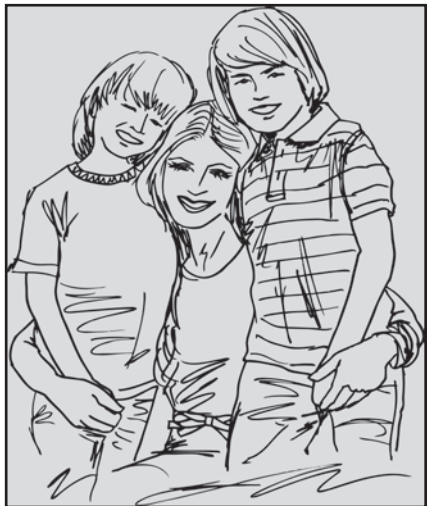
Well, Dear Fellow Members, it was then that I turned to Life-Study Fellowship and learned how to put my trust in God. And He had good things in store for me.

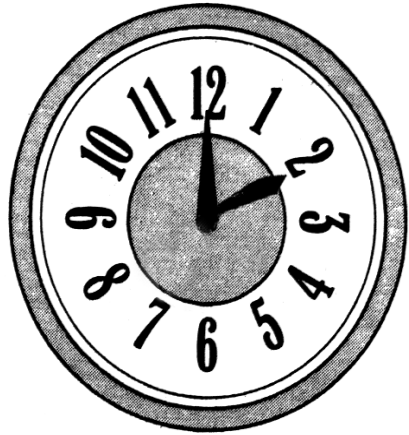
Mix all ingredients except Jello together. Then, stir in Jello, mixing well. Chill for at least 3 hours.

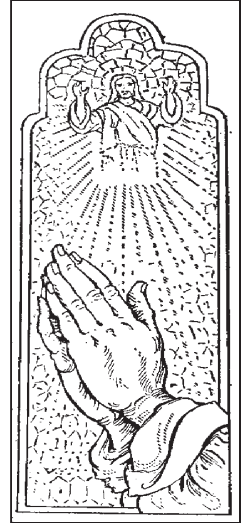


If you are interested in making arrangements through your will, we suggest you talk with an attorney who can explain the tax advantages and ways to go about making such a bequest.
