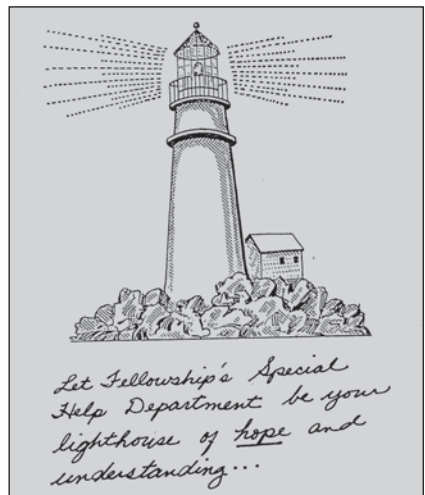
*bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.”*

# The Book Of Proverbs Teaches Us To Seek Wisdom, Learn And Pass It On!



We are highlighting the wisdom of the Bible's Book of Proverbs this year, Dear Member. In this edition of FAITH, we're discussing the passage of Proverbs 1:5, which says: *"A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels."*

As we wrote in earlier issues of our magazine, the Proverbs display the wise teachings of King Solomon as he advises his son and everyone who reads these Verses. Here, Solomon talks of how wise people

approach the task of learning, and then work to understand what they have learned. Toward that end, Proverbs 1:6-7 says, *"To understand a Proverb, and the interpretation; the words of the wise, and their dark sayings ... The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction."*

With those words Solomon is sharing how faith in God helps us gain knowledge, while at the same time he cautions that turning away from faith and its enlightenment will lead us into foolish actions and the absence of knowledge.

In addition to these lessons in Proverbs . . . recognizing wisdom and accepting the lessons it teaches, then acting wisely upon we are being taught . . . there is another element of information from Proverbs, Dear Friend. Once we have gained knowledge and understanding of why we should do something a certain way, we can make use of that guidance by passing it on to benefit others.

After all, Jesus taught His Disciples about the lessons and wisdom of God so they would go out among the people and reach even more listeners. That is how God's messages of love, faith and prayerful devotion have been carried around the World!

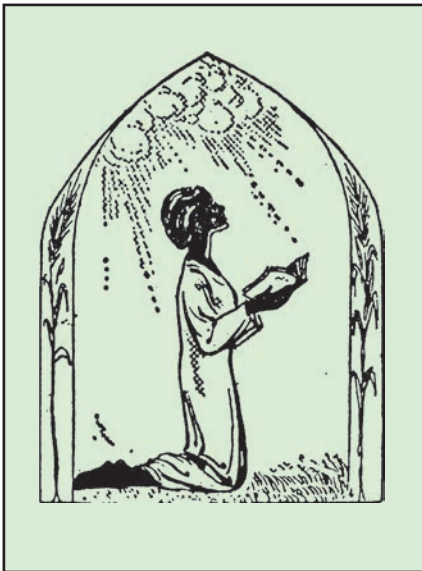
*“I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ;*

# **Helpful Household Hints**

No one organizes and cleans their homes better than our Fellowship Friends! We publish a page of their Helpful Household Hints in each Faith Magazine to share their tips. If you've got an idea to add, Dear Member, just write us and we'll be happy to include it right here!

### **CLEAN INDOOR PLANTS**

Here's a good use for microfiber cloths. To take dust off live or artificial leaves, lightly dampen a microfiber cloth and wipe it over the leaves. This will add a bit of moisture for real plants, too.

### **A BUG-FREE ROOM**

Place several drops of oil of lavender or peppermint on a cotton ball or two. Put them into a small jar or margarine container. Poke a few holes in the lid and cover. Put around the room.

### **BANISH SPLIT ENDS**

Add a few drops of lavender oil to a tablespoon of warm (not boiling) castor or sweet oil. Apply just to the ends of your hair. Then wrap hair with plastic wrap or a plastic shower cap and cover with a warm towel. (You can warm the towel quickly by tossing it into the dryer for a few minutes. Leave

the oil mixture on your hair for at least 30 minutes and then shampoo with cool water to wash it away.

### **NO MORE STINKY SHOES**

Lay a piece of plastic wrap into shoes and put a drop of clove oil on a cotton ball and place it on the plastic wrap to remove the odor. Don't forget to take this out of the shoes before you put them on. You also can use empty film canisters as shoe odor-busters. Poke holes into the lids and put the essential oil perfumed cotton balls inside.

### **CLEAN WINDOWS**

Here's a recipe for a window cleaner that smells nice!

12 to 16 ounces water

1/2 cup white or apple cider vinegar

1/4 cup rubbing alcohol (70%)

1-2 drops lavender, cinnamon, clove or orange essential oil.

Combine the ingredients in a spray bottle and start cleaning!

### **SCENTED LIGHTBULBS**

Dab a bit of oil of clove, peppermint or eucalyptus on a cool lightbulb. When you turn on the light, the scent will drift throughout the room.

### **SPRINGTIME RICE**

This pretty, green rice casserole is a favorite with Mrs. R. W., a Member from Florida. It tastes just as good as it looks, too!

Ingredients: 1 cup uncooked rice . . . 1 can cream of mushroom soup, undiluted . . . 1 small jar Cheese Whiz . . . 1/2 cup chopped onion . . . 2 packages chopped, frozen broccoli, cooked . . . 1/2 cup diced pimentos . . . 1/2 cup chopped celery . . . 3 tablespoons margarine.

Cook rice and add soup and Cheese Whiz. Cook onion and celery in margarine and add to rice mixture. In a two-quart casserole dish, layer half of the rice mixture, then half of the broccoli, then half the pimentos. Then, make a second layer of each and bake for 45 minutes at 325 degrees.

### **BEST EVER CHESS PIE**

Ron K. from Georgia sent in this delicious pie recipe. It is so good, and so different!

Ingredients: 4 eggs . . . 1½ cups sugar . . . 1 tablespoon corn meal . . . 1 tablespoon vinegar . . . 1/4 cup evaporated milk . . . 1 stick butter, melted . . . 1 teaspoon vanilla . . . 3/4 cup chocolate chips . . . 1 unbaked pie crust.

Beat eggs; gradually add sugar, corn meal, vinegar and evaporated milk to mixture. Stir in melted butter and vanilla. Cover bottom of pie crust with chocolate chips; pour mixture over chips and bake at 325 degrees for one hour. Cool before cutting.

### **MEAT SALAD**

Mrs. Casey S., a Member from Colorado, sends in this recipe that's guaranteed to spice up a spring luncheon.

Ingredients: 2 cups canned Spam meat cut into small pieces . . . 1 cup cooked green peas . . . 1 cup mayonnaise . . . 2 hard-boiled eggs, chopped . . . 1 small onion, chopped . . . 1/2 cup chopped sweet pickles.

Just combine all the above ingredients, mix lightly with a fork, then chill and serve on top of lettuce. It's a light and quick entree for lunch or dinner that's sure to please your guests.

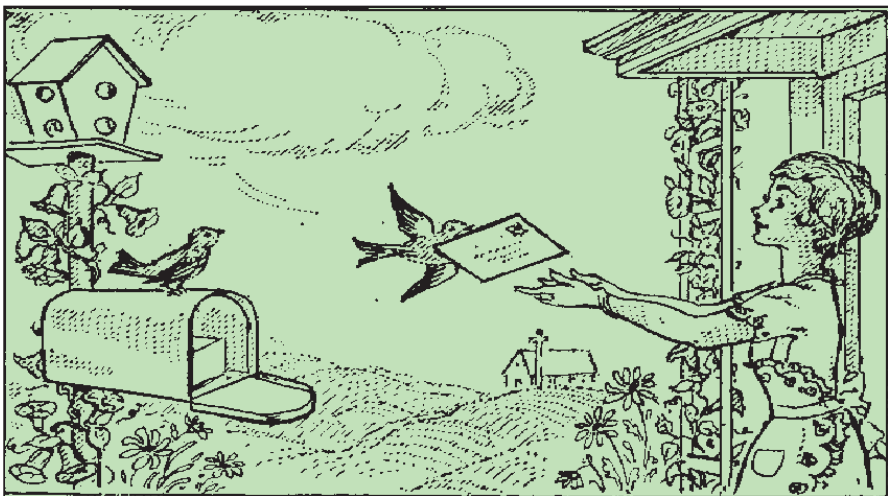

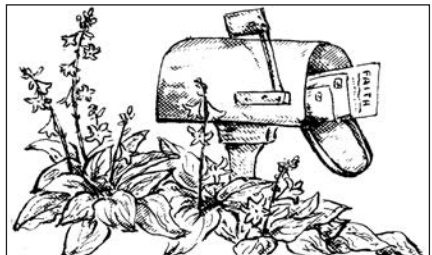

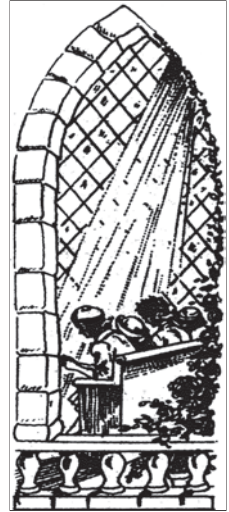

Otherwise, some or all of your property will be split up according to state law, which may leave your property in ways you did not want or intend.

Therefore, whether or not you include a bequest to Life-Study Fellowship, we encourage you to seek the services of an attorney to have a will drawn up if you have not already done so.
